## 2025 Particulars

- The Vermilion and District Rotary Music Festival uses the Alberta Music Festival Association Provincial Syllabus along with local addenda. The full syllabus, both provincial and local, are available here.
- Registration opens 12:00 AM, January 1, 2025 and is available at vermilion.musicfestivalsuite.com.
- Registration closes 11:59 PM, February 16, 2025, but late registrations are accepted until 11:59 PM, February 28, 2025
- Any registration fees submitted during the Late Registration Period incur a Late Registration Penalty of \$10.00
- To register, all Parents/Guardians and Teachers/Group Leaders must make a Profile with the Vermilion and District Rotary Music Festival's MusicFestivalSuite Portal before a Participant makes their own Profile. A Parent/Guardian can create a Profile for their minor children easily from within their own Profile. A Teacher/Group Leader can create a Profile for their ensemble(s) easily from within their own Profile. If you already have a MusicFestivalSuite Profile with another festival, you can Export your Profile from that festival to the Vermilion and District Rotary Music Festival easily from within your Profile with that festival.

#### **Strings**

Complete String Concertos may ONLY be played in String Concerto Classes.

Provincial Eligibility Note: For performances at the Provincial Festival, all repertoire recommended from the following Strings classes must be fully memorized for the Provincial Festival, including sonatas. Only sonatas entered in the String and Keyboard Sonata classes on page 18 may move on to the Provincial Festival non-memorized (in Provincial Class 320 only).

Canada West Eligibility Note: All repertoire at Canada West must be fully memorized, including sonatas.

#### **Violin - First Year of Instruction**

#### NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A PROVINCIAL MUSIC FESTIVAL RECOMMENDATION

There is no limit on the number of selections that may be played but time limits may be in effect. For time limit and performance format, contact your Local Community Festival Administrator.
